Occupancy of "small" tourist accommodation establishments in 2021

Concerns tourist accommodation establishments with fewer than 10 bed places

Increase in the number of overnight stays provided in rooms for guests and agritourism lodgings with fewer than 10 bed places compared to 2020. In 2021, tourist accommodation establishments with fewer than 10 beds accommodated 874.5 thousand tourists, with 3.1 million overnight stays provided for them. The occupancy rate of bed places in this type of establishments was 22.1%.

The results presented in this news release have been prepared on the basis of an annual sample survey of rooms for guests and agritourism lodgings with fewer than 10 bed places. The sampling frame was based on the Tourist Establishments Registers maintained by municipal and gmina offices.

Occupancy of rooms for guests and agritourism lodgings in 2021

In 2021, 874.5 thousand tourists were accommodated in tourist accommodation establishments with fewer than 10 bed places, including 830.2 thousand (i.e. 94.9% of the total) domestic tourists and 44.3 thousand (i.e. 5.1%) foreign tourists. Compared to 2020, the number of total tourists accommodated decreased by almost 2.0 thousand. Taking into account the origin of tourists, there was an increase in the number of tourists from abroad by 64.6% and a decrease in tourists from Poland by 2.3%.






Chart 1. Tourists in tourist establishments with fewer than 10 bed places

In 2021, in small accommodation establishments the most frequent overnight visitors were tourists from Germany, who accounted for 47.1% of the total number of foreign tourists accommodated in this type of establishments

Among foreign tourists the most numerous were tourists from Germany, who accounted for 47.1% (in 2020 - 32.0%) of all foreign tourists accommodated in this type of establishments. Tourists from Ukraine were also numerous – they accounted for 12.5% of all foreign tourists accommodated (in 2020 - 26.7%) in rooms for guests and agritourism lodgings. In 2021, tourists mostly visited establishments located in Zachodniopomorskie Voivodship - 21.3% of all tourists accommodated in small accommodation establishments. They also stayed in large numbers at establishments located in the following voivodships: Dolnośląskie (18.3%), Pomorskie (16.6%) and Małopolskie (10.0%).






The vast majority of tourists chose to stay in rooms for guests - 634.1 thousand (i.e. 72.5% of all tourists), while 240.3 thousand (i.e. 27.5%) stayed in agritourism lodgings. During the holiday months (July and August), 420.9 thousand tourists stayed in small accommodation establishments, which accounted for 48.1% of the total number of persons accommodated throughout the year. Domestic tourists more often stayed in accommodation establishments in August (203.2 thousand tourists) than in July (196.7 thousand), while the largest number of foreign tourists stayed in accommodation establishments in July (10.7 thousand).

In 2021, 3.1 million overnight stays were provided in rooms for guests and agritourism lodgings, of which 2.9 million were provided to domestic tourists and 174.0 thousand to foreign tourists. Compared to 2020, there was a 15.7% increase in the number of total overnight stays, 14.4% in domestic tourists and 43.2% in foreign tourists.

Overnight stays by foreign tourists were dominated by overnight stays by tourists from Germany, which accounted for 51.3% of the total overnight stays provided to foreign visitors (in 2020 - 25.3%). Overnight stays by tourists from Ukraine accounted for 22.3% (in 2020 - 44.6%). The vast majority of overnight stays in small establishments in 2021 were provided in rooms for guests (68.5%).

In rooms for guests and agritourism lodgings, 43.2% more overnight stays were provided to foreign tourists in 2021 than in 2020 In 2021, most overnight stays were provided to tourists in Zachodniopomorskie Voivodship - 24.4% of the total number of overnight stays provided in establishments with fewer than 10 bed places, followed by Pomorskie (16.9%), Dolnośląskie (15.8%) and Małopolskie (9.1%) Voivodships.

Between July and August, approximately 1.6 million overnight stays were provided, accounting for 52.1% of the total overnight stays provided in rooms for guests and agritourism lodgings in 2021. Tourists spent an average of 3.5 nights in small accommodation establishments (3.0 in 2020); they stayed slightly longer in agritourism lodgings (4.0 nights) than in rooms for guests (3.3 nights). In 2020, the average overnight stay of one tourist in a room for guests was 2.7 nights, and 4.0 nights in an agritourism lodging, similar to 2021.

The occupancy rate in small establishments was 22.1% in 2021 (in rooms for guests - 27.9%, and in agritourism lodgings - 15.2%).
