



# Why this Communication ?



Importance of border regions: 40% EU territory; 30% EU population (150 million), 30% EU GDP

**BUT** less economically developed, lower access to public services


Navigating different legal and administrative systems is still complex, long and costly




# **"Border Effect" – Unused potential**

- Border obstacles lead to lost potential GDP;
- Removing 1/5 of all obstacles could lead to +2% GDP in border regions;
- Corresponding to 1 million new jobs
- Problems are more deeply felt where there is a greater level of interaction

# Building evidence of CB interaction to inform decision-making


"Limited availability of statistical and geospatial data on CB flows reduces the scope for genuine crossborder policy development and decision-making" EC: COM(2017)534

### **Data needs – Perspectives** Pilot project on cross-border data collection (CBDC):

- Collaborative project of several statistical institutes: BE; FR; DE; IT; SI; PL; DK; NL
- To develop methodology to produce CB data in a cost-effective way making optimal use of existing data and expertise

## Data gathering – Perspectives and tendencies

- Grid based data (1km<sup>2</sup>) offer opportunities to focus on areas close to the border
- Mobility: Cross Border accessibility
  - Rail: comparing cross-border and domestic connections (REGIO)
  - Road: assessing network efficiency (JRC)
  - Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/1926 on the provision of EU-wide multimodal travel information services: offers interesting opportunities to enhance accessibility analysis


### Facilitating exchanges amongst Cross-Border stakeholders
